We are a group of men, of all different ages, some of us are married and some of us are not. Most of us live in Willaston and surrounding areas. We meet together for fellowship and, as most of us are Christians, we also meet to support one another in our faith.

We generally meet during the second or third week of the month, alternating

between a Tuesday / Thursday evening. Our usual pattern of meetings is one month we'll meet in church (finishing no later than 9.00pm), for a short service, followed by a talk, then the next month, we have a pub-social and so on.

You do not need to live in Willaston to join us, and you don't need to be Christian either. Equally, you don't need not come to every meeting — come to what you want to and don't worry about the rest! You will be very welcome wherever and whenever you chose to join us!
